If some of the study units in the module are already in your PSP, those will not be added. Thus, consider whether adding the whole module or just study units is more suitable to keep your PSP in order.

Complementary language studies

- In complementary language studies are study units available in both basics as well as at advanced levels, depending on the language.
- Language studies are available in Spanish, French, German and Estonian languages; annual variation is possible.
- Check what is the language of teaching in the study unit implementation.
- In English language studies offered in complementary competence studies you can deepen your oral and written language skills.
- Laurea's opportunities to offer language studies are limited. By planning language studies in your Personal Study Plan, you can influence what will be available in the future. Group sizes must be sufficiently large.
- The "Go abroad - Multicultural Teamwork and Student Mobility" study unit (3 credits) supports students going on exchange programs.

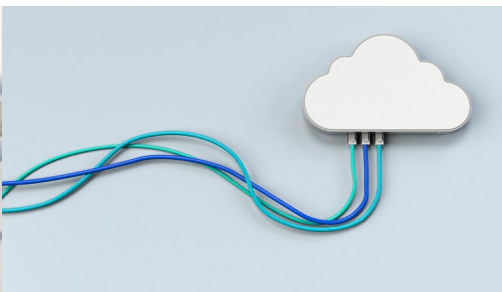
